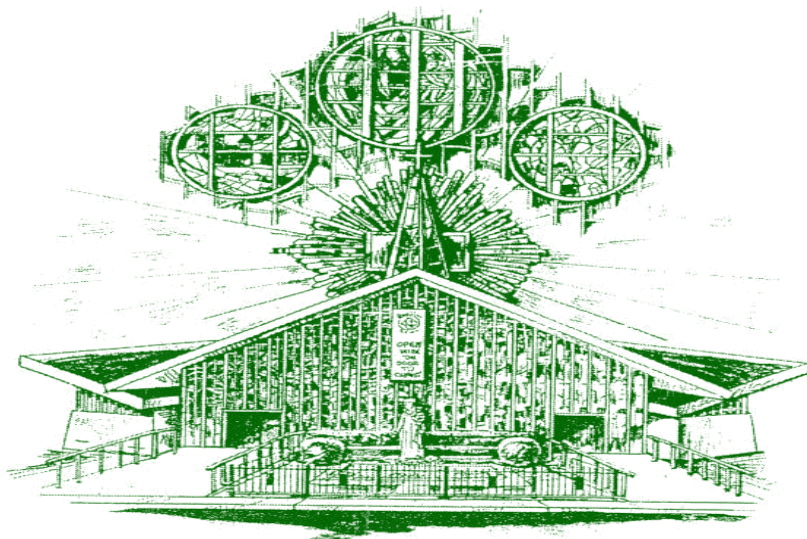

Ash Wednesday is the beginning of the Holy Season of LENT. Ash Wednesday is a day of universal Fast and abstinence in the Church.

EXTRA MASS SCHEDULE DURING LENT

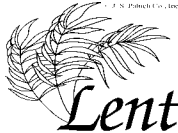
6:30 p.m. Monday, Wednesday & Friday

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.
